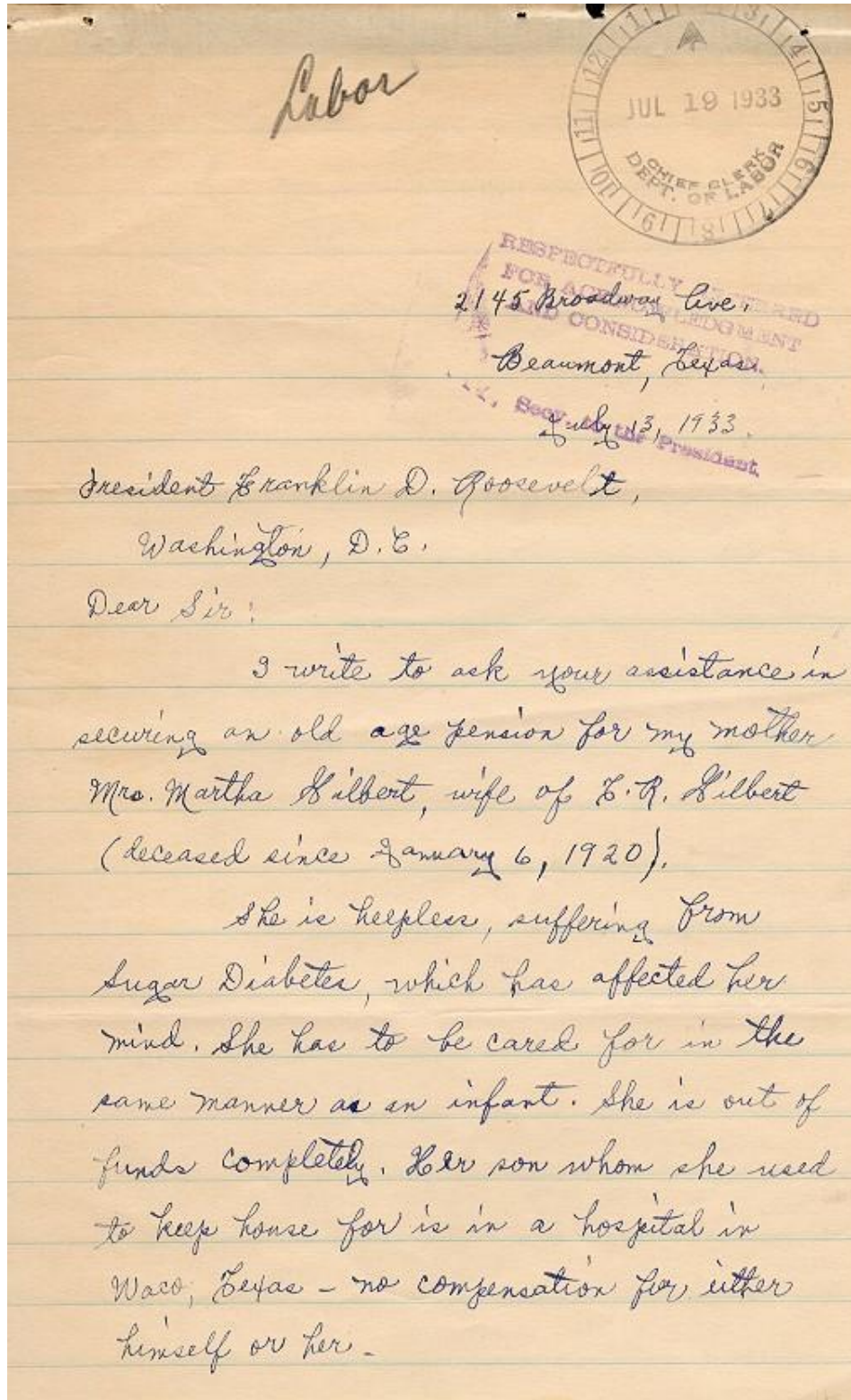


Resource Sheet #1
