Who are the main characters or historical figures?

List only the characters or historical figures that are most important to the event.

Where does the event take place?

Include the time period as well as location. Add details that help you see the setting.

What is the problem or conflict? What is happening?

Explain what problem or conflict is taking place. If there are multiple conflicts, list all of the major ones.

List what happens in the event in order of occurrence.

Sequence the important events in the order they happen. Be sure to include all the events that are important to the outcome of the event.

Describe how the event ends.

How is the problem or conflict resolved? Write the outcome here.

What is important about this event?

Reflect on why you think this event is important. What did you learn?
