


PART 2: How you complete PART 2 depends on whether you believe that The Stamp Act was fair or not.

- what is shown on the stamp
- what document(s) the stamp is to be placed on
- what the money raised by selling this stamp will be used for

If your answer to PART 1 **opposes** the Stamp Act: use the space below to design your own protest of the Stamp Act. Your protest must include the following:

- who is protesting
- how are they protesting (may **not** include violence)
- where are they protesting
- what is their message
