Governor Ehrlich to Tour Facility of Recent Recipient of TEDCO's Maryland Technology Transfer Fund

ANNAPOLIS, Md. – Governor Robert L. Ehrlich, Jr., and the Maryland Technology Development Corporation (TEDCO) will tour the office and laboratory of Amulet Pharmaceuticals, a startup biotech company located at the University of Maryland Baltimore County's business incubator.

Amulet Pharmaceuticals is one of 10 Maryland companies that received early-stage seed funding through TEDCO's Maryland Technology Transfer Fund (MTTF). The Governor will discuss the passage of the stem cell bill and appear with TEDCO leadership for the first time since signing the bill into law
