

WHAT: bwtech@UMBC is a 71-acre research and technology community at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC). bwtech@UMBC Incubator and Accelerator is home to 22 start-up and 12 emerging high-tech and biomedical companies. It also operates an Idea Lab to help UMBC students and faculty develop businesses.

UMBC has graduated 32 companies from the incubator program and has accommodated 90 tenants since the program's inception. A recent incubator graduate, In Vitro Technologies, was sold to Celsis International for \$30 million.

The companies at the incubator and accelerator provide over 250 jobs, including internships to UMBC students. The companies work closely with UMBC faculty and staff. The program has successfully helped companies acquire Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR), Maryland Technology Development Corporation (TEDCO) and Maryland Industrial Partnerships (MIPS) funding.

The incubator and accelerator buildings have the capacity for another 100,000 square feet of development, providing an additional 250 jobs.

UMBC leases the facility and converted it from a single-use to multi-use facility. The bwtech@UMBC incubator receives support from Maryland TEDCO and Baltimore County.
